

ORDINANCE NUMBER 40

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES UPON CERTAIN BRIDGES AND STREETS OF THIS CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. ALL THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC PROHIBITED FROM BRIDGE LOCATED ON THOMPSON LANE. In order to provide for the safety of vehicles, all through truck traffic is prohibited from traveling over the bridge located on Thompson Lane that passes over Holloman Creek.

SECTION 2. PENALTY. Any person, driver, operator, owner, company, firm, corporation, or chauffeur violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail, not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. SEVERANCE CLAUSE. That if any section, sentence, phrase or clause of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such section, sentence, phrase or clause shall not impair the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, phrases or clauses of this

ordinance; the Board of Aldermen hereby declares that it would have passed the remaining portions of this Ordinance had it known that such section, sentence, phrase or clause would be held invalid.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

WHEREUPON, this ordinance was read three times and approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri on this 10TH day of JULY, 1989.
