**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TRESPASS IN THE SECOND DEGREE
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY
OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI,**

***BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF
ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:***

SECTION ONE. Trespass in the second degree. —

1. A person commits the offense of trespass in the second degree if he enters unlawfully upon real property of another. This is an offense of absolute liability.

2. Trespass in the second degree is an Ordinance violation.

SECTION TWO. PENALTY.

Any person who shall violate any of the other terms and regulations of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than three hundred dollars.

SECTION THREE. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

WHEREUPON, this Ordinance was read three times and approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri, on this 11th day of October 2004.
