ORDINANCE NO. 70___

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ARCADIA VALLEY SPORTS COMPLEX AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. REGULATIONS OF THE ARCADIA VALLEY SPORTS COMPLEX.

The rules and regulations established for the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex are not to hamper and restrict our citizens, but are adopted so as to allow our citizens and guests maximum use and enjoyment of the facilities without annoyance and discomfort.

The rules and regulations here established will be enforced by the Police Department. Any person convicted of a violation of any rule or regulation herein established shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Any activity which is likely to result in injury or loss of life is prohibited. The various sports and activities are to be played in the location provided for them and in open areas when such sport or activity will not create a hazard to others.

The Arcadia Valley Sports Complex is closed from 12:00 midnight until 6:00 a.m. except when kept open for special events as hereinafter provided:

- a. The Board of Aldermen, upon application of more than twenty-four (24) hours in advance, may grant permission to the applicant to remain in the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex beyond 12:00 Midnight.
- b. The Sports Complex lights with the exception of security lights and dusk to dawn lights will normally be turned off at 12:00 midnight
- c. Signs stating the hours of operation will be posted in the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex. The following rules and regulations shall apply to the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex
 - 1. <u>Vehicles</u>: Cars, trucks, busses or similar vehicles, as well as motor bikes of all types and other similar vehicles are allowed only in those areas of the park where roadways are provided. Motor vehicles shall not be parked on grassy areas and must restrict themselves to roadways.
 - 2. <u>Motion Vehicle Traffic</u>: The speed limit of motor vehicles traveling through the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex shall be 10 miles per hour.
 - 3. <u>Damaging Park Property</u>: All property in the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex belong to the citizens of Arcadia. No property animate or inanimate, shall be damaged, destroyed or removed from the park or moved from the location where it is installed or planted. No holes shall be dug and no structure, either temporary or permanent, shall be erected unless authorized.

- 4. <u>Use of Facilities</u>: It is intended that all events shall be scheduled through the Scheduling Coordinator to be appointed as hereinafter provided. When there are no scheduled events, it is intended that the use of the facilities be on a first come, first serve basis. In general, the facilities and equipment are to be used for the purpose which they are designed. Use of the facilities and equipment for purposes other than for which they were intended is prohibited.
- 5. <u>Firearms, Explosives or Air-Powered Weapons</u>: No firearms, explosives, fireworks or air-powered weapons are to be brought into, possessed or set off in the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex area, unless a special permit is obtained in advance from the Board of Aldermen.
- 6. <u>Hunting</u>: Hunting in Arcadia Valley Sports Complex is prohibited. No person shall molest, hunt, kill or frighten any wildlife creature or domestic animal in any manner whatsoever.
- 7. <u>Presence of Animals</u>: Domestic animals are not permitted in the Parks unless the animal is on a leash. Horses may be ridden and kept in the confines of the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex property during approved fairs and events held on said property.
- 8. <u>Public Demonstrations: Concerts: Speeches:</u> No exhibitions, concerts, parades, dances or similar activity shall be allowed in the Sports Complex unless a special permit is obtained in advance from the Board of Aldermen and the time of the event is approved by the Scheduling Coordinator. Application should be made at Arcadia City Hall at least thirty (30) days in advance.
- 9. <u>Camping</u>: Overnight camping of any sort, within any type of structure be it permanent or temporary, within the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex, must have prior approval from the Board of Aldermen and the Scheduling Coordinator.
- 10. <u>Peddling</u>: No person or organization other than those obtaining permission of the Board of Aldermen, shall expose or offer for sale, rent, or trade, any article or service of station, or place any stand, cart or vehicle for transportation, sale or display of any merchandise, within the limits of the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex.
- 11. <u>Picnicking with Fires</u>: Picnicking with or without fires may be done in any area where it will not interfere with other recreational activities. Fires are permitted only within grills. The grills and picnicking facilities are for family and group picnics. Use of these facilities as "free kitchen" restaurants or similar activity is expressly prohibited.
- 12. <u>Disposal of Trash</u>: All trash is to be deposited in trash containers located within the sports complex boundaries. These trash containers are designated for use only by Park users. The use of the containers for any other purpose is forbidden.

SECTION 2. SCHEDULING COORDINATOR OF THE ARCADIA VALLEY SPORTS COMPLEX - APPOINTMENT

The Mayor of the City of Arcadia, subject to the approval of the Board of Aldermen, shall appoint some suitable person as Scheduling Coordinator for the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex, who shall hold his position for a term of one year unless removed by the Arcadia Board of Aldermen.

SECTION 3. SCHEDULING COORDINATOR - DUTIES

The Scheduling Coordinator shall have the following duties:

- a. The Scheduling Coordinator shall have the responsibility of scheduling all organized events to be held at the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex.
- b. The Scheduling Coordinator shall have the responsibility of collecting all fees and remitting said fees to the City of Arcadia.
- c. The Scheduling Coordinator shall cooperate in providing all information relative to his position to his successor and shall transfer to his successor all books, papers, and records relevant to his position as Scheduling Coordinator.
 - d. The Scheduling Coordinator shall serve without compensation.

SECTION 3. PENALTIES

All persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus the cost of the repairs.

SECTION 4. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

- 6. <u>Hunting</u>: Hunting in Arcadia Valley Sports Complex is prohibited. No person shall molest, hunt, kill or frighten any wildlife creature or domestic animal in any manner whatsoever.
- 7. <u>Presence of Animals</u>: Domestic animals are not permitted in the Parks unless the animal is on a leash. Horses may be ridden and kept in the confines of the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex property during approved fairs and events held on said property.
- 8. <u>Public Demonstrations: Concerts: Speeches:</u> No exhibitions, concerts, parades, dances or similar activity shall be allowed in the Sports Complex unless a special permit is obtained well in advance from the Board of Aldermen. Application should be made at City Hall at least thirty (30) days in advance.
- 9. <u>Camping</u>: Overnight camping of any sort, within any type of structure be it permanent or temporary, within the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex, must have prior approval from the Board of Aldermen.
- 10. <u>Peddling</u>: No person or organization other than those obtaining permission of the Board of Aldermen, shall expose or offer for sale, rent, or trade, any article or service of station, or place any stand, cart or vehicle for transportation, sale or display of any merchandise, within the limits of the Arcadia Valley Sports Complex.
- 11. <u>Picnicking with Fires</u>: Picnicking with or without fires may be done in any area where it will not interfere with other recreational activities. Fires are permitted only within grills. The grills and picnicking facilities are for family and group picnics. Use of these facilities as "free kitchen" restaurants or similar activity is expressly prohibited.

SECTION 2. PENALTIES

SECTION 3. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
