

ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A JUDICIAL EDUCATION FUND AND ADDITIONAL COURT COSTS WITH RESPECT THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Section 479.260 RSMo authorizes the Municipal Court to establish a Judicial Education Fund to provide for the continuing education and certification of Municipal Judges, a judicial education and training of the Court Administrator and Clerks of the Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen for the City of Arcadia have determined that it is in the best interest of the City to establish such a judicial education fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen for the City of Arcadia, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Judicial Education Fund – Court Costs: The Municipal Court for the City of Arcadia is hereby authorized to establish a judicial education fund to provide for the continuing education and certification of Municipal Judges and the judicial education and training of the Court Administrator and Clerks of the Municipal Court. The Municipal Court shall assess an additional fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) to be designated as court costs on each case. One Dollar (\$1.00) shall be withheld from all fees collected and deposited in the Judicial Education Fund to be administered by the Municipal Court. Any fund balance that exceeds \$1,500.00 for each Court employee, shall be turned over quarterly to the City Treasurer.

Section 2. Severability. The Sections, paragraphs, sentences and clauses of this ordinance are severable; and if any section, paragraphs, sentence or clause of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional by the Court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall have no effect upon the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences and clauses of this ordinance.

Section 3. Repeal Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri.
