AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF UNLICENSED "ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES" UPON THE STREETS AND SIDEWALKS OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In order to promote the safe movement of traffic and pedestrians upon the streets and sidewalks of the City of Arcadia, Missouri, the operation of unlicensed "ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES" upon the public streets and sidewalks of the City of Arcadia is prohibited.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of this ordinance, the term "ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES" shall include all three and four wheel vehicles designed primarily for use over terrain other than paved streets.

SECTION 3. For the purposes of this ordinance, "license" refers to a state license that a vehicle receives in order to be operated on a public street or highway within a state.

SECTION 4. All licensed vehicles must have at least the minimum insurance amount as provided in the state statues of Missouri.

SECTION 5. Violation of the provisions of this Ordinance or failure to comply with any of its requirements shall constitute a misdemeanor. Any person who violates this Ordinance or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and in addition shall pay all costs and expenses involved in the case. Each day such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

WHEREUPON, this Ordinance was read three times and approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri, on this 31 day of August, 1994.
