## ORDINANCE NUMBER 11

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT AND ANY PRISONERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. MUNICIPAL JUDGE. The presiding officer of the Municipal Court shall be the Judge of the Circuit Court, Associate Division, of Iron County, Missouri, who shall be duly elected and qualified according to law.

SECTION 2. MUNICIPAL COURT. The Municipal Court of Arcadia shall be styled the "Circuit Court of Iron County, Missouri, Arcadia Municipal Division."

SECTION 3. RULES OF COURT. The Municipal Court shall be governed by the rules of the Supreme Court of Missouri, and the rules of the Forty-second Judicial Circuit of Missouri which do not conflict with the rules of said Supreme Court. The Municipal Judge may make and promulgate such rules for the conduct of the Municipal Court as do not conflict with either the rules of the Supreme Court or the rules of the Forty-Second Judicial Circuit.

SECTION 4. CITY ATTORNEY. The City Attorney shall act as prosecuting officer on behalf of the City in any cases wherein violations of city ordinances are charged. The City Attorney shall so act in the Municipal Court and in any

other division of the Circuit Court to which any such case may be transferred.

SECTION 5. PRISONERS. The Iron County Jail shall be utilized for confinement of prisoners sentenced by the Municipal Court, upon such fiscal terms as shall be negotiated between the City and Iron County.

SECTION 6. COST OF FEEDING, HOUSING, MEDICAL EXPENSE, ETC., OF PRISONERS - HOW PAID. All cost of maintenance, bedding, of medical expenses necessary for any person during his confinement for a violation of any ordinance shall be paid by such person to be taxed as costs and may be recovered by execution provided, however, that the County Jailor shall be paid his fees for such services quarterly out of the City Revenue.

SECTION 7. SEVERANCE CLAUSE. That if any section, sentence, phrase or clause of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such section, sentence, phrase or clause shall not impair the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, phrases or clauses of this ordinance; the Board of Aldermen hereby declares that it would have passed the remaining portions of this ordinance had it known that such section, sentence, phrase or clause would be held invalid.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be and the same are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
