

ORDINANCE NUMBER 67

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ALONG  
HIGHWAY 21 WITHIN THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF  
ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. NO PARKING PLACES.

At any time it shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle to stand in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device:

Along State Highway 21 within the boundaries of the City of Arcadia,  
Missouri.


SECTION 2. PENALTY.

Any person who shall violate any of the terms and regulations of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

WHEREUPON, this Ordinance was read three times and approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri on this 14 day of August, 2000.
