ORDINANCE NUMBER 64

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 16 OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That SECTION 1 of ORDINANCE NUMBER 16, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. BOARD OF ALDERMEN TO ISSUE LICENSE.

No PERSON, FIRM, CO-PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR CORPARATION SHALL ENGAGE IN ANY BUSINESS, EMPLOYMENT, OCCUPATION, AGENCY AMUSEMENT OR EXHIBITION, OR OWN, MANAGE, OPERATE OR CONTROL ANY PUBLIC BUILDING UNLESS SAID PERSON, FIRM, CO-PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION SHALL FIRST APPLY TO THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN FOR A LICENSE; AND IF THE BOARD IS CONVINCED THAT THE APPLICANT HAS COMPLIED WITH ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES OF THIS TOWN GOVERNING THE SSUANCE OF A LICENSE TO DO OR ENGAGE IN THE MATTERS FOR WHICH SAID LICENSE IS APPLIED FOR, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE TO SAID APPLICANT A LICENSE UPON THE PAYMENT OF AN ANNUAL LICENSE TAX OR OCCUPATION TAX OF \$12.00, EXCEPT SUCH OCCUPATIONS, BUSINESSES, AGENCIES, AND VOCATIONS HEREINAFTER REGULATED BY ORDINANCE OR EXEMPT FROM SUCH TAX BY LAW.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

WHEREUPON, this Ordinance was read three times and approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri on this <u>14</u> day of August, 2000.
