AN ORDINANCE REGULATING MINORS IN POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Any person under the age of twenty-one years, who purchases or attempts to purchase, or has in his or her possession, any intoxicating liquor as defined in section 311.020 RSMo or who is visibly in an intoxicated condition, or has a detectable blood alcohol content of more than two-hundredths of one percent or more by weight of alcohol in such person's blood is guilty of a misdemeanor.

A person is in an "intoxicated condition" when he/she is under the influence of alcohol, a controlled substance or drug, or any combination thereof.

Section 2: The penalty for minor in possession of alcohol is a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance in so far as they are in conflict are hereby repealed.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
