**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY
OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI,**

***BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF
ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:***

SECTION ONE. ASSAULT

A person commits the crime of assault in the third degree if:

- (1) He attempts to cause or recklessly causes physical injury to another person;
- (2) With criminal negligence, he causes physical injury to another person by means of a deadly weapon;
- (3) He purposely places another person in apprehension of immediate physical injury;
- (4) He recklessly engages in conduct which causes a grave risk of death or serious physical injury to another person; or
- (5) He knowingly causes physical contact with another person, knowing the other person will regard the contact as offensive or provocative.

SECTION TWO. PENALTY.

Any person who shall violate any of the other terms and regulations of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than five hundred dollars.

SECTION THREE. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

WHEREUPON, this Ordinance was read three times and approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri, on this 14th day of February 2005.
