AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 5 OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, RELATING TO THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:

That there will be added to this Ordinance,

SECTION 16. Any person filing for a seat on the Board of Aldermen, or currently serving on the Board of Aldermen, shall not be in arrears to the City (i.e. Taxes, Water bill, City Sticker, and/or Dog Tags) for his/her term of office. If an arrearage occurs to the City, after a members election to office, the Board of Aldermen shall take this matter up in a closed session. At that time voting shall occur and, in the event of a majority vote, the member can be dismissed from office. SECTION 17. Any person holding a seat on the Board of Alderman shall comply with any and all Ordinances of the City of Arcadia. In the event that he/she does not comply with said Ordinances, the Board of Alderman shall take the matter up in a closed session. At that time voting shall occur and, in the event of a majority vote, the member can be dismissed from office.

WHEREUPON, this ordinance was read three times and approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Arcadia, Missouri, on this $\frac{9 \, \text{th}}{2}$ day of March, 1998.
