AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING RULES AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA, MISSOURI, as follows:

#### Section 1. Parking at the Curb.

- (A.) No vehicle shall be parked with the left side of such vehicle next to the curb, except on one-way streets, and it shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in a street other than parallel with the curb and with the two right wheels of the vehicle within 12 inches of the regularly established curb line, except that upon those streets that have been marked for angle parking, vehicles shall be parked at the angle to the curb indicated by such marks.
- (B.) At any time it shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle to stand or park in any place where the standing of a vehicle will interfere with the normal flow of moving traffic, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a policeman or traffic control device.

#### Section 2. Penalties for Violation.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than five (\$5.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 3. City's right to civil action for cost of enforcing the parking restrictions.

Nothing in the preceding sections shall be construed as abandoning or limiting the city's right to bring suit for all expenses attending the enforcement of the parking restrictions, when performed by the city, in any court of competent jurisdiction in the name of the city of Arcadia, against any person violating this article.

### Section 4. Validity.

Should any section or provisions of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

# Section 5. Repeal of conflicting ordinance.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.

## Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect upon its passage and approval, and publication as provided by law.
